1. Introduction

4. Legal Basis for Processing (if applicable)

5. Sharing and Disclosure

We may share data with:

We do not sell personal information for monetary consideration.

6. Data Security

We implement reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards designed to protect personal data. However, no method of transmission over the internet or electronic storage is 100% secure.

7. Data Retention

We retain personal data only as long as necessary for the purposes described and to comply with legal obligations.
